

A GREENER CHARTER

Through its new partnership with 'ClimatePartner', Ocean Independence can now offer its charter clients the option to offset their emissions and support important environmental projects around the world ...



There's nothing that can match the feelings of anticipation and excitement which go hand in hand with booking a yacht charter. Now a deep sense of satisfaction can be added to the mix with the knowledge that you have offset the carbon emissions from your charter and supported lifechanging environmental projects in the process.

Our new partnership with ClimatePartner, a pioneering solution provider for corporate climate action, enables our clients to make mindful, climate-conscious decisions and make a positive impact on the environment when booking their yacht charters.

A vital part of our broader Environmental Social Governance programme, our carbon offsetting initiative has been in the planning since 2018. "We developed it before Covid but realised our clients and charter guests were probably not focussed on it during the pandemic," says Daniel Küpfer, Managing Director of Ocean Independence. "We believe the time is right for it now."

Selecting the right company to partner with was an exacting process, and ClimatePartner stood out. Founded in Munich in 2006, the company now has more than 5000 clients around the world and offices in 13 countries. "During the selection process we had many meetings with various companies and ClimatePartner came across as really passionate about what they were doing at both a personal and company level," says Thomas Carey, DPA and Project Manager at Ocean Independence, and instrumental in implementing our partnership with ClimatePartner.

ClimatePartner is independently verified by TÜV Austria, an international specialist in environmental matters, "so the whole process with them is very transparent – both for us and for the Client, so we know the money will be used correctly," he adds.

"Trust is essential and we are confident we have found a trustworthy partner because we don't want to participate in greenwashing," says Küpfer. "We recognise the vulnerability of the environment and our responsibilities and as a company we want to shape the future of yachting – the entire industry needs to develop in that direction. Offsetting carbon emissions from our charters should really have an impact, and it is just the beginning of a much wider environmental programme for Ocean Independence."

Another part of the appeal of ClimatePartner was the water-based projects the carbon offsetting programme supports. We have selected four projects to support, all of which are sustainable and have far-reaching benefits both to local communities and the wider environment.

So how does it work? All you need to do is simply decide whether to offset your charter's emissions and we'll take care of the rest. Our easy to use offsetting calculator, developed in house, uses complex technical data to show exactly how the emissions will be offset and where the money will be invested. "From A to Z there is full transparency so our clients can have full confidence and feel affiliated with the causes they are supporting," says Küpfer. After the charter is completed, ClimatePartner will issue a certificate so our clients can see exactly what they've invested in and where the carbon emissions have been offset.

Offsetting the carbon emissions from our yacht charters is just the beginning of our companywide commitment to making Ocean Independence more environmentally friendly. ClimatePartner has been working with us to calculate our corporate carbon footprint and supporting us to make greener choices. "We are planning to have a fully implemented ESG programme, and we have introduced initiatives such as offsetting business travel, recycling, reusing of materials, avoiding single-use plastic and organising team events such as participating in the World Cleanup Day," says Küpfer.

"On board our managed yachts, we are avoiding single use plastic and working closer with the crew so the food and beverage is purchased locally and not flown in. We think it's rewarding because there is awareness amongst our staff in the office and amongst the crew, and there is also a lot of awareness amongst our charter guests," he says. "Our obligation is to come up with the solutions."







The yachting industry as a whole is evolving to address climate change," says Carey. "We already see at the shipyards that clients often ask for hybrid propulsion concepts for their new builds." says Küpfer. "More and more we see the use of solar cells, and there is a lot going on in terms of research into alternative fuels and a general reduction of emissions to meet the target of the International Maritime Organization." (The IMO is aiming for each vessel to have reduced its greenhouse gas emissions by at least 40% by 2030 compared with 2008.)

There is also a shift in the way owners are buying and using their yachts altogether. "We are seeing that there is a slowly increasing demand for a shared ownership of a yacht, so the footprint of creating it remains the same but it's more cleverly shared between different owners," says Küpfer. "For future generations, property becomes maybe less important and people are more willing to share when they are aware that this is a good use of their impact on the environment. This is just the beginning."



Do I need sailing experience or qualifications?

To skipper a bareboat charter or flotilla yacht, you need to hold a practical sailing certificate equivalent to RYA Day Skipper Practical qualification or RYA International Certificate of Competence (ICC). For charters in Greece, you must now have the ICC certificate. You must also be assisted by at least one competent crew member over the age of 18.

For charters in Croatia, Malta and the Canaries, at least one member of the crew or the skipper will also need a VHF licence.

If you wish to take part on a flotilla but do not have an RYA qualification then you may like to choose our 'Learn on flotilla' option on the Ionian flotilla in Greece.

Alternatively, RYA qualifications can be obtained by RYA sailing schools in the UK or from one of our overseas centres in Gibraltar, Greece, Turkey or Croatia.

Which Flotilla will suit my experience level?

Less experienced and experienced skippers alike will benefit from the help and advice from the flotilla lead crew and their knowledge of the local area. He will provide daily weather forecasts and guide you through the cruising area, making sure you visit the best places. Facing its first fully open season since 2017, the BVIs are back with a fully refreshed look ...





Yacht charter has always been a huge part of tourism in the British Virgin Island, and why shouldn't it be? The archipelago includes more than 60 islands, cays, and islets, of which only 16 are inhabited, providing a haven of "line-of-sight" sailing and with protection from Atlantic swell and nearly no tide, it's ideal for seasoned and novice crew alike. Known for their beautiful beaches, clear waters, and luxury resorts, there's plenty to keep even the most eager of charter crews busy.


BVI TOP PICKS

BITTER END YACHT CLUB

Hurricane Irma flattened the whole estate in 2017, and over the past 5-years Bitter End 2.0 has risen out of the sandy ashes. Located in the North Sound of Virgin Gorda for over 50 years, Bitter End Yacht Club has attracted sailors from around the globe with its quaint charm. It provides near-perfect sailing conditions, endless sunshine, and crystal-blue waters surrounded by colourful reefs, the North Sound is a sailing and watersports mecca.

Bitter End's return to the BVI may have been long, but in doing so, it has built a sustainable hideaway and with the same authentic charm they have become known for. Alongside a 26-berth marina, with 70 mooring buoys a short tender ride away, the shoreline boasts a gourmet market, boutique shops, a fantastic casual restaurant and two bars serving up Caribbean cocktails.

For sailors spending a whole day at Bitter End, the resort's watersports club has a range of dinghies, windsurf gear, SUPs and foil boards for guests to get active on the water with - and with a Dive centre next to the marina, exploring the nearby reefs is easy. Make sure you're at the club for 2pm to take advantage of the daily dinghy regattas and SUP exploration challenges.







WRECK OF THE RHONE

Built in 1865, the Rhone was one of the largest and most advanced Royal Mail Ships in operation in the late 1800s. In October 1867, the ship was sailing from England to the Caribbean when it was caught in a hurricane and sunk near Salt Island in the BVI. The wreck is now a popular dive site, known for its well-preserved condition and the artefacts that have been recovered from it, including coins, ceramics, and other objects. Whilst local dive centres offer a range of excursions to explore the wreck, due to large sections being in shallow water, it's possible to pick up one of the 8 National Park Day mooring buoys, pop on a snorkel and spend a good hour exploring the reefs that have taken over the wreck.

SANDY CAY

Previously owned by the Rockefeller family, this tiny uninhabited island between Tortola and Jost van Dyke is now looked after by the National Parks Trust of the Virgin Islands. Make sure that you arrive early to pick up one of the very few National Park day mooring buoys. A short swim or tender ride ashore will see you embrace your own deserted island adventure. The soft sand is home to hermit crabs, and the woodland has a few species of geckos and Iguanas living amongst the short trees. A small trail around the island encourages visitors to discover the island's native habitat and scales to the highest point of just 3.5m above sea level. However, from this vantage point, you'll get a great view of both Tortola and Jost van Dyke.









There are no facilities on the island, so take ashore a chill box of beers and a rucksack of snacks for the full beach picnic experience. Just make sure that you head back to your yacht that you don't leave anything behind and this little paradise stays pristine for the next visitors.

CALLWOOD RUM DISTILLERY

Located in Cane Garden Bay, Callwood Rum Distillery has been producing rum in the same building for over 400yrs. With over 50 gallons of rum produced daily, a tour of this working distillery is fascinating. For just \$5 per person, one of the team will give a very laidback private talk on how their distillation process works, walk you through the sugar cane fields and then demonstrate how their methods and machinery haven't changed in for centuries. Afterwards, you're invited back into the ramshackle interior to sample 5 of their rums.

Once you've sampled the local tiple, Cane Garden Bay's beachfront has an array of bars serving fantastic drinks using rum distilled just a few hundred meters away. Take your time to wander from bar to bar, finishing up watching a famous BVI sunset sipping a sweet rum cocktail.





THE PERFECT 7-DAY BVI ITINERARY

In just one week, you can explore the best of the BVI with still plenty of time to relax. In our itinerary, the navigation is easy, and you'll spend every night either on a pre-booked mooring buoy, or at a marina where staff are on hand to help you berth.

DAY 1:

Sail from Tortola to Bight Bay on Norman Island. On your way, be sure to pick up a mooring buoy I at Pelican Island for a snorkel off "The Indians". Once settled in the Bight, jump in the tender and explore the caves off Treasure Point before relaxing at Pirates beach bar, then a night jumping off the floating bar "Willy T's".

DAY 2:

Sail up to Cooper Island. En route, stop off at Salt Island to snorkel over the Wreck of the Rhone. At Cooper Island, be sure to visit their famous rum bar with over 260 varieties to choose from.

DAY 3:

It's time to wake up early to be one of the first to arrive at The Baths on Virgin Gorda. These luna-like rock formations are very popular with all tourists, so an early arrival ensures you can explore in peace. Back onboard, sail up to the North Sound to spend the rest of your day at Bitter End Yacht Club. Explore everything the club has to offer, and if you stay for dinner, the Lobster pizza is great!

DAY 4:

Head off on a 20nm downwind sail to Cane Garden Bay. As you sail between Beef Island and Great Camanoe, stop over at White Bay on Guana Island to swim with turtles off Monkey Point. Arriving in Cane Garden bay, walk to Callwood Rum Distillery for a tour before they shut at 4pm, and then wander back to the tender via the many beach bars.

DAY 5:

Set your final destination as Great Harbour on Jost Van Dyke, but sail via Sandy Cay for the remote Caribbean island sensation. Moor close to the shore in Great Harbour, and enjoy an evening in the legendary Foxy's.

DAY 6:

Hop around to White Bay, tuck inside the reef on the western end of the beach, drop anchor and swim ashore to Soggy Dollar bar for their famous Painkiller cocktail. After a day of fun on the beach, swim back to your yacht and sail to Soper's Hole on Tortola for your last night onboard.

Day 7:

It's time to return your charter yacht back to base. Enjoy a morning sail up the coast of Tortola to your final destination.


TORTOLA

JOST VAN DYKE

Although it's one of BVI's smallest islands, Jost Van Dyke (named for a Dutch privateer) still encapsulates an abundance of charm and history. Intrepid explorers can discover the ruins of early sugar mills, still-surviving explorer footpaths, and near-endless amounts of interesting wildlife here. Archaeological evidence suggests that Jost Van Dyke was visited by civilizations as diverse as the Arawak tribe, Caribs, Africans, the British, and — naturally — the Dutch. Despite its diminutive stature, Jost Van Dyke's rich melting-pot history has fostered some of the Caribbean's best dining, with barbecue, Indian and seafood dominating the menus at the isle's various beachside eateries.

OTHER NOTABLE ISLANDS



HVAR, CROATIA THE ISLE OF NATURAL BEAUTY

The ideal yachting region for over 2400 years, alongside Dubrovnik the historic city of Hvar is the most popular destination for boaters in Croatia.

The island of sunshine, beautiful beaches, great restaurants and peaceful coves. To put it simply, it is one of the most beautiful islands in the world. Except for the town of Hvar, Stari Grad has been a favourite destination for boaters for more than 2400 years. It can be said that the "Stori Grod", as it is known among the locals, was the first sailing town in Croatia.

The reason for this is the bay which pierces the heart of the city like a spear. The bay, a few miles long, is one of the safest natural ports of the Adriatic. Its V shape offers protection from all the winds except for the north-western one, and it is specifically this wind that is responsible for the popularity that this bay enjoys among boaters. The mistral wind, which begins blowing sometime



before noon, becomes gradually stronger until sunset, when it dies down almost completely. It serves as a driving force for boaters, windsurfers and kite surfers. They are easily recognized by their wide smiles. The mistral is known as a pleasant summer wind, which blows with uniform speed and does not change its direction. It fits into the picture of Stari Grad perfectly, with its dreamy thousand-year-old houses.

For boaters renting some form of land transportation, we recommend driving to the top and enjoying the beautiful view of the Kabal shaped like a hand with five fingers. As if nature wanted to give itself a high five for this wonderful creation. The Stari Grad bay is full of places popular among boaters, and even more importantly, it offers safe anchoring.

Boaters will find it useful that a restaurant where they can relax is open during the summer. On your way to Stari Grad, after leaving Tiha, you will approach Zavala. This spacious and deep cove has an anchoring area, a restaurant is open there in the summer, and the position of the sun enables sunlight to shine into the cove late into the evening.







THE ISLE OF NATURAL BEAUTY

The coves in the southern side of the Stari Grad nautical treasure chest are smaller and more intimate. The first one is Gračišće, which has a beautiful pebble beach and a small dock approachable with a dinghy. You can spend a day on the beach in the shade of a thick pine forest with the sounds of cicadas in the background. Maslinica is also noteworthy, as it is the only sand beach in the bay.

Most of the coves on the southern side are shaded in the afternoon, making them suitable for people who do not like spending too much time sunbathing. If you want to spend the night in the town itself, Stari Grad has many docking berths, and anchoring is possible in the centre of the bay. It will be especially interesting to boaters sailing with children.


Over the last several years, boaters have been flocking here, because there is more than enough room for everyone, and the port is full on stormy days. In such weather conditions, it is best to spend the day in one of the best natural covers on the Adriatic and wait for the weather to calm down.

Greece, located on the southern tip of the Balkan peninsula, has common borders with Albania on the northwest, Republic of Macedonia and Bulgaria directly to the north, and Turkey

on the furthest eastern point. The geographical diversity of where Greece stands is not just by land, but also by sea. Greece has always been considered a sailors paradise due to the perfect weather and the island hopping that is available. With several departure points, Greece has endless possibilities when it comes to exploring the sea, so the best way to see everything is to book a boat! Hire a boat in Skiathos and sail Athens or rent a boat in Lefkada and make your way to Corfu. It's up to you!

Pricing and Information on hiring a boat in Greece

In Greece, the long stretches of coast give you several dimensions of sailing allowing you to have more options when it comes to where you'd like to rent. Greece has always been well known as having several popular ports spread widely around the country. The sailing season in Greece

is normally really standard starting in April and running into October. With tourist season, you will have to keep in mind that July and August will be the busiest months of the year.

Due to the difference in sailing areas, the price can vary depending on your project. In general, the highest prices for rentals start at the end of June and go into the end of August. During this high period, the pricing may be higher due to the demand and favourable weather conditions. On average, you can expect to pay on average 500€ a day for a catamaran charter in Greece and 400€ for a sailboat. For lower price points, boat rentals drop dramatically at the end of September. For motorboats, it is best to sort by the type of project you are interested in. Since Greece offers plenty of activities on motorboats, you will be able to find a boat on every budget. Usually, you can find motorboats starting at 150€ per day.

Boat Availability

For sailors globally, Greece has always been one of the top destinations for yacht charters and boat rentals. If you're looking for a weekly yacht charter in the Cyclades or one of the other popular ports like Athens, Lefkas, you will have to book the boat well in advance. On average, more than 50% of the charters for Greece are already booked by March and more than 75% by the beginning of May. At SamBoat, we advise that you define your project and book a boat as early as possible. In some instances, you can book closer to the date of departure depending on the port, but the inventory decreases.

For day boats, the functioning is a bit different. Usually, for motorboats rented for one day, the recommended time period to book is 2 to 3 months to ensure availability.

Do you need a license to charter a yacht in Greece?

Depending on what type of boat you would like to rent, there are different pieces of legislation for each. If you are looking to hire a motorboat, a license is required if the boat has more than 30hp, if less, no license is needed. If would like to charter a yacht, you will need a valid license as well as a nautical CV detailing the previous boats you captained as well as the different waters you navigated.

If you are new to sailing or do not hold a license, you don't have to rent a bareboat. Most of the boats in Greece are available with skipper so this would be a perfect option for you.

Sailing areas in Greece

Yacht charter in Greece is popular with both experienced and novice sailors. Greece has areas with











specific sailing and sightseeing characteristics, here are the areas where you can go sailing in this beautiful and popular country.

Ionian Islands

The Ionian Islands are located in the western part of Greece and extend into the Peloponnese. There are seven main islands: Corfu, Zakynthos, Paxos, Kefalonia, Ithaca, Kythira and Lefkada. The climate is mild most of the year and during spring there can be light rainfall. These islands are ideal for all types of sailors, especially for beginners. The best bases for yacht charter are Corfu and Zakynthos.

The Sporades

The Sporades islands are located almost in the middle of the Aegean Sea. Each of the islands has characteristics and a nature that will amaze you. Skiathos is the most popular island and the most visited by young travellers thanks to its party atmosphere. The best time to charter a boat and sail is during spring and summer because of the warm weather. During the winter it can rain and caution is advised when sailing.

The Cyclades

The Cyclades group have 23 large islands spread out in a circle. They are the most popular group of islands in Greece, including Santorini and Mykonos. You can charter a boat near Fira and admire the cliffs from the sea. During July and August is Meltemi season, which means you'll encounter rain and light winds that will make your sailing

more interesting and a little tricky. Even so, each island is worth a visit to admire its beauty.

The Dodecanese

The Dodecanese islands lie between the Cyclades island and Turkey, southeast of Greece. Kos and Rhodes are the most popular islands of the group, famous for their medieval architecture. Charter a catamaran in Greece and enjoy the quiet beaches of the area. From April to September, the weather is pleasant, whereas the coldest and rainy month is January. The Dodecanese islands are ideal for all types of sailors.

Saronic Gulf and Hydra Gulf







Cid Harbour has quite a bit of history attached to it. During WW2 the Allied Navy ships anchored here prior to the battle of the Coral Sea.

DAY 2 - WHITEHAVEN BEACH

Whitehaven Beach is a must see on the itinerary of just about every traveller to the Whitsundays. It is one of the most famous beaches in the world and is constantly ranked as one of the best beaches by numerous sources, year after year. The beach stretches over 7km along Whitsunday Island and offers two bushwalks with fantastic views – Hill Inlet bushwalk (1.3km return) and Whitehaven to Chance Bay bushwalk (7.2km return).

DAY 3: NECK BAY

Neck Bay on Shaw Island is one of the most southerly anchorages within the Whitsunday Escape cruising area and is seldom visited. Explore the bush track that leads from one side of the island to the other. Neck Bay offers good fishing; swimming, beach walking & bird watching

DAY 4: HAMILTON ISLAND

Hamilton Island is the largest resort in the Whitsundays and is essentially a community of its own, on an island. For a small marina fee, you can berth in the marina overnight and make use of the resort facilities. Fabulous if you need to restock your vessel with food and drinks, or if you want to enjoy a restaurant meal and some pampering on land.

DAY 5: NARA INLET

Nara Inlet is a very protected anchorage on Hook Island that is popular with all boaties. A unique factor about Nara Inlet is the cave at the furthest end, where you will find Ngaro Aboriginal cultural

site. The bush track up to the cave is well-marked, gentle and accessible by people of all fitness levels. Interpretive signage along the way explains the significance of the site and the cave paintings.

DAY 6: BUTTERFLY BAY

Butterfly Bay is a local favourite for its excellent snorkeling and diving, protection from most wind conditions and namesake butterfly habitants found on the bay's beach at certain times of the year. Butterfly Bay is a Marine National Park Green Zone. As such it offers fabulous snorkelling, diving abundant marine life and wonderful bird life.

With its great protection from the south/south east winds and vast marine, butterfly and bird life, all easily accessible from the beach or off your boat, you may find yourself spending an extra night or two here to explore this diverse bay.

DAY 7: STONEHAVEN, HOOK ISLAND

Stonehaven is a beautiful anchorage popular with Whitsunday boaties due to its close proximity to some of the Whitsundays best snorkeling and diving spots.



Cruise from Nassau to Compass Cay (approx. 70nm) where you can swim with the nurse sharks right in the marina or take a stroll down the quaint nature paths to the secluded beach on the other side. The walkway here is painted with colorful buoys and signage along the way giving you a true local feel. From here you can anchor off near Rocky Dundas Caves. These two caves are hidden inside a large rock with natural skylights at the top. In order to enter the cave you must swim into a shallow hole where you end up inside a cavern of stalactites and stalagmites. It is quite awe inspiring. With a mask, snorkel and fins, the sea life surrounding this rock is so colorful and it's shallow.

DAYS 3-4: COMPASS CAY TO STANIEL CAY

On to Staniel Cay (10nm) where you can dock at the marina or anchor nearby in several well protected areas. With its handsome stone architecture, good food, and friendly bar, the small but intimate Yacht Club attracts adventurers from around the world. Next door at Sampson and Big Major is home to the native wild pigs which often swim a few yards out to greet you. A must see is "Thunderball Cave" where the fish eat right out of your hand. You may want to dine ashore at Royal Plantation Island at Fowl Cay a private resort island, which is run by ex-yachties.

DAYS 4-5: STANIEL CAY TO LITTLE BELLS CAY

Cruise from Staniel Cay back north to Little Bells Cay / Cambridge Cay for the night (10nm). There is a hidden, shallow cut in between the long stretch of beach where no boat would venture as it does dry up at low tide. Enjoy a swim and let the current carry you through as if riding a small rapid. White sand and crystal blue water is the perfect canvas to see a few small sting rays swim by. A short hike up to the lookout will give you an amazing vantage point of the surrounding islands.

DAYS 5-7: LITTLE BELLS CAY TO HIGHBOURNE CAY

Head from Little Bells to Highbourne Cay and Allan's Cay (approx. 20nm) to see the famous Iguanas roaming the beach and traverse through this jagged yet beautiful cut. You may opt for a short snorkel around the Norman's Cay sunken airplane which sits in shallow water not far from this northern spot in the Exuma chain. There is a marina at Highbourne or you can choose to anchor further down in a more protected location. Cruise back to Nassau from Highbourne and if time allows, a quick dip off of Rose Island.

The ship is escorted by Arctic fulmars. The first ice appears; still discreet, it seems to be dancing around you. At the end of a fjord, you will find yourself before an immense glacier. Black-legged







kittiwakes share an iceberg, while Arctic terns fly over the area. Aboard the ship or a Zodiac dinghy, you will admire the power of nature while becoming aware of its fragility. The music of the thaw has begun its soft melody: a combination of cracking, roaring, murmuring and fizzing defies the silence of the polar desert.

On land, you will set foot on malleable earth, known as moraine. Only moss, lichen and a few rare flowers have managed to adapt and to take hold here, forming the tundra. On these inhospitable lands, Svalbard reindeer and Arctic foxes coexist with walruses, lying on the beach. It has been a long time since the Pomor settlers, of which traces remain, came to hunt them.

Here, the lord of the Arctic, the polar bear, is never very far away. The crucial aspects of this cruise involve searching and keeping an eye out. On board, the team of naturalists will scan the horizon so they can provide you with marvellous sightings of wildlife and, in particular, the polar bear. The region's elusive fauna upholds its mysteries while the uncertain nature of the encounter bestows an indescribable magic upon it.






